Here are some great tips to keep you organized as you and your skater prepare for the show.....

1. **Check your child's name on the Ice Show skater list** in the Glenview Ice Center lobby to make sure his/her name spelled correctly. If not, contact Joe Townsend at 224-521-2088 with corrections *by April 24.*
2. **Highlight your important information** such as rehearsal times, as you read this packet.
3. **Fill out the handy "Quick Reference Form of Your Skater's Information"** with your child's specific information and post it on your refrigerator, bulletin board or any other handy place where you can refer to it quickly and easily.
4. **Complete and send in any forms** (such as video order form or volunteer form) to the Glenview Ice Center *by May 17.*
5. Carpool whenever possible.
6. **Make sure your skater has his/her skate guards** at all rehearsals and shows, they must wear them!!!!

Being in the ice show is a wonderful experience, but it does take a significant commitment for both parents and skaters. Open Tech Rehearsal Schedule: ALL SKATERS MUST ARRIVE BY 3:45 PM!!!

Monday, May 17 @ 4 pm - For FIRST HALF skaters only

Only SOLOISTS are in costume! 2 run-throughs

“A” soloists will skate in the first run-through,

“B” soloists will skate in the second run-through.

Skaters should arrive at 3:45 pm and must be seated and ready to skate at 4 pm!

Tuesday, May 18 @ 4 pm - For SECOND HALF skaters only

Only SOLOISTS are in costume! 2 run-throughs:

“A” soloists will skate in the first run-through,

“B” soloists will skate in the second run-through.

Skaters should arrive at 3:45 pm and must be seated and ready to skate at 4 pm!

This open tech rehearsal, open to parents, is for skaters performing in the first half of the show only. Parents may sit in the East bleachers, while skaters will report to their designated row in the West bleachers. We will run through the show 2 times, in order. Some groups, especially the tot finale, will be asked to repeat their number as needed. After the 2nd run-through of the skater's number(s), parents may claim their child from the West bleachers and go home! SOLOISTS: refer to your soloist packet for your detailed instructions.

Closed Dress Rehearsal Information

The dress rehearsal is “closed” to spectators (including dressing room volunteers) with NO exceptions! Your cooperation and patience while waiting is greatly appreciated.

Closed Dress Rehearsal Schedule:

Wednesday, May 19

First half skaters arrive by 3:45 pm

Second Half skaters arrive by 4:45pm

ALL skaters are to be in costume and must enter through their assigned stage doors and use their dressing rooms! Skaters are to be dropped off to and picked up from their dressing room for Wednesday's closed dress rehearsal.

For all rehearsals, the groups will be led to the ice by a staff member or parent volunteer when it is their turn to skate, and then will be led back to the bleachers or dressing rooms when they're done.

Because this is the first run-through of the entire show, we cannot predict how long it will last and ask that you please be patient while waiting for your child. We will be rehearsing the Grand Finale for the first time between the 2 halves and may need to run through it several times. SOLOISTS: refer to your soloist packet for your detailed instructions.

Parents of skaters 6 and under may stay in their skater's dressing room if it's not uncomfortably crowded. Otherwise, parents (except dressing room volunteers who **MUST** remain IN the dressing rooms) must wait in the lobby or return after an hour or so to pick up their skater(s) from the dressing room(s).

BLEACHER & DRESSING ROOM ASSIGNMENTS FOR REHEARSALS & SHOWS

Bleacher Assignments:

On Monday & Tuesday, May 17 & 18 at the Open Tech Rehearsals, skaters and their families will be sitting in the bleachers during the rehearsals (parents on the east, skaters on the west). Each group will have a specific section of the bleachers assigned to them, designated by a sign. Skaters should remain in their assigned bleacher location unless they are on the ice or on their way to the ice with their group. Skaters in multiple groups should initially sit with their group that is skating first, and then sit with their group that is skating next.

Dressing Room Assignments (for all rehearsals & shows):

All skaters whose dressing rooms are locker rooms A - D and their escorts must use the west **stagedoor 1** facing Landwehr Rd. Skaters whose dressing rooms are upstairs must use the north **stage door 2** by the handicapped parking area and proceed immediately upstairs. Skaters whose dressing rooms are in the Studio rink must enter through the front doors and go through the lobby to the Studio rink.

For all rehearsals, the groups will be led to the ice by a staff member or parent volunteer when it is their turn to skate, and then will be led back to the bleachers or dressing rooms when they're done.

SKATERS MUST WEAR SKATE GUARDS TO REHEARSALS AND SHOWS!!!

Costume Information

Costumes and Appearance:

Costumes will be distributed in early May during group rehearsals. Kathy Brickman or her assistants will be on hand to describe how it should be worn and any finishing touches to be made.

There is to be **no eating or drinking while in costume** (except water) at dress rehearsals or shows. If **ANY** part of the costume is missing, (bootcovers, headpiece, etc.) the skater will **NOT** be permitted to skate in that show.

At showtime, skaters must stay out of the lobby while in costumes. If the skater **MUST** go into the lobby, he/she **must** be covered by a long garment (such as a robe).

Skaters with long hair must wear it tied back in a ponytail, braid or bun. **NO HAIR EXTENSIONS!!!** No jewelry should be worn with the costume.

To prevent panty lines, girls should not wear underpants with their costumes.

Purchasing Tights & Other costume Parts:

None of the costumes include tights. Therefore, parents must purchase tights (for girls only) if they are required by the costume style. **Parents should purchase Mondor brand SUNTAN MATTE MICRO-FIBER TIGHTS.** Tights should be available at **Big Lou's located in the Ice Center.** Tights will generally cost between \$13 and \$16. *(Be sure to check the Mondor Sizing Chart so you purchase the right size for your skater and consider buying an extra pair just in case!)*

NO OVER-THE-BOOT TIGHTS ARE ALLOWED! Skaters who come dressed in over-the-boot tights will be expected to cut or remove them before taking the ice for dress rehearsals and shows.

All costume questions should be addressed to Costume Coordinator Kathy Brickman.

Rental Skates and Guards:

There is no charge to rent skates for rehearsals. For show week, rental skates with guards will be issued to all who need them just before the start of each half's tech rehearsal on Monday & Tuesday. All you need to do is arrive a few minutes early, fill out a Rental Skate Deposit Card at Skate Rental and leave a \$10 deposit (cash or check). You can then keep that pair and use them for the rest of the week! **Skates and guards should be returned to skate rental immediately after the child's last performance,** in the same condition in which they were issued, and your \$10 deposit will be returned. You may also return the skates between 9:00 am & 5:00 pm Monday, May 24 through Friday, May 28. **There will be a \$1 per day late charge on all pairs not returned by 6:00 pm on Friday, May 28.**

ALL SKATERS MUST HAVE THEIR NAMES ON THEIR SKATE GUARDS!!

If you have rental guards, we'll provide a piece of masking tape and a permanent marker for you to write your child's name on them. If you have your own guards, please write the skater's name on them.

- All seats are reserved. You may choose your seats at the time of purchase.
- Cost per ticket: \$7.50
- There is no limit on the number of tickets you can purchase . You do not have to buy tickets for all shows.
- Do not buy a ticket for a skater who is performing except Tots, who may join you in the stands after the Tot Finale - all other skaters will be in the Grand Finale at the end of the show and will remain in their dressing rooms for the entire show. Skaters performing in the 2nd half may sit with you during most of the 1st half, as long as their costume is completely covered and they have a ticket for their seat .
- Approximately 800 seats available per show - SPECIAL ACCESS seats for disabled individuals and wheelchair tickets are available but only in limited quantities. These seats will be located on the main floor by the rink doors so occupants should be cautioned to dress warmly.
- THERE ARE NO REFUNDS OR EXCHANGES FOR PURCHASED TICKETS! (Please check your tickets before you leave the building!)

PARKING:

Whenever possible, PLEASE CARPOOL. During the shows, the Ice Center will arrange for additional parking at the High School Administration building (to our South) and Winkelman School (2 buildings to our North). Parking staff will be on hand and signs will be posted showing you where the drop-off/pick-up zones are and where additional parking is located. **Please note there is no parking allowed on Landwehr Rd., Hospital Rd. or on the side streets off Landwehr Rd.**

BACKSTAGE PARENT VOLUNTEER INFORMATION

Each year we ask for parent volunteers to help coordinate and supervise the skaters backstage in the dressing rooms during shows and full rehearsals. A pass will be issued to the volunteer for the show in which they are working. **Parent volunteers are crucial to the success of the show and the safety of the skaters. We truly rely on parents to help us out in this area.**

If you are able to volunteer and can attend one of the parent volunteer meetings, please fill out the form below and submit it to the office by **Friday, May 7.**

As a backstage volunteer during the tech & dress rehearsals and shows, you must remain in your assigned dressing room the entire time the skaters are present, until the last skater has been claimed by his/her parent. Skaters performing in the first half (except Tots) will be in their dressing rooms **for the entire show**, while skaters in the second half will be in their dressing rooms from their arrival time until the end of the show. This is because all non-Tot skaters will be performing in the Grand Finale at the end of the show! This means that you should not buy yourself a ticket to a show at which you'll be volunteering. Parents will be assigned to the same dressing room as their child. Volunteer Coordinator Karen Perry will call you with your Volunteer Assignment. At the **Parent Volunteer Meeting**, you will receive the "Guidelines for Ice Show Parent Volunteers" handout which will explain the duties and responsibilities in detail. Please do not wear open toed shoes in the dressing rooms!

Professional Photography:

Group & individual photographs will be taken for the 2010 Ice Show . . .

Krphotogs Photography will be here to take posed group and individual portraits of ice show skaters. Individual and group shots will be taken for all groups **except** Synchro Teams, Dance Troupes, Opening #, FS1 & UP, Production #'s and the Soloist #. All other groups will be led by staff from their dressing rooms to the studio rink for **group shots**, before or after they skate, **during dress rehearsal, Wednesday, May 19**. When all group shots are done, the skaters will be led back to their dressing room. At the conclusion of the dress rehearsal, skater may return to the Studio Rink to pose for individual shots. The photographer will stay until 8 pm to make sure every skater has the opportunity to have an individual shot taken. Proofs will be available for viewing at Krphotogs Photography web site. The website for the photos will be www.krphotogs.com/rockin_with_the_pop_stars by Monday, May 31. They will also take action photos during the two Saturday ice shows. A CD with all the images from group and solo numbers, individual digital files or prints will also be available from the web site.
